Full of military history including Victoria Cross recipients, the Boer War, Civil War, the RAFs WW2 highest scoring fighter pilot & military working dogs.



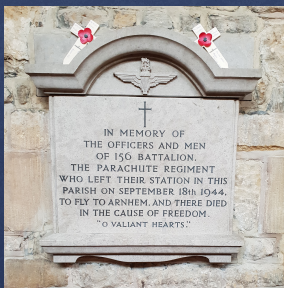
War Graves Tours
